This term our reading focus will be:

- Poetry—Creating images

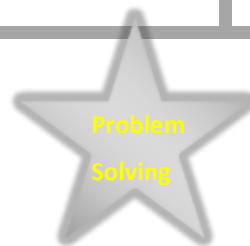


Numeracy

Science 1

Pupils will develop their understanding of nutrition and cooking skills then research and make their own healthy pizzas



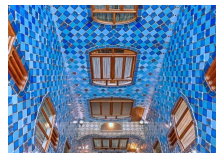
1st—History
