Our Current Topic is – Traditional Tales

We will be reading a range of traditional stories such as 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and 'Little Red Riding Hood'. We will be planting our very own 'magic' beans, just like Jack and talking about the ways that we can care for our 'magic' beans in the hope that they will grow. We will be observing the changes that take place over time and talking about the key parts that start to develop-roots, stem, leaves and flowers. This term, we will also be looking at the ways that we can stay safe and healthy with a particular focus upon 'Stranger Danger.'

Literacy



In Literacy, we will be reading a range of traditional stories. We will be writing in a range of genres and this will include character descriptions as well as our own stories. We will also be applying the key aspects of sentence writing within our work, which includes finger spaces, full- stops and capital letters.



In Numeracy, we will be continuing to develop our knowledge of numbers to 20. We will continue to practice the concepts of addition, subtraction, doubling and halving.
