Reading

This term our reading focus will be:

- Persuasive Writing—The Iliad and the Odyssey
- Argument and Debate - Linked to PSHE
- Poems with Humour
- Information texts about the Ancient Greeks.



Writing

This term our writing focus will be:

- Non-Fiction—Persuasive writing
- Non-Fiction—Argument and debate
- Fiction—Mythological writing
- Poetry—Humorous Poems



Numeracy

This term our numeracy focus will be:

- Multiplication and Division
- Fractions
- Decimals and Percentages

Children will also develop their mental math skills, through the 'Shooting Math's Stars' scheme. Each week children will be tested and move up the different star levels.



Science 1

Pupils will compare and group materials and understand reversible and irreversible



Science 2

Pupils will learn to describe the movement of the Earth and other planets relative to the sun.



RE

Pupils will focus on learning about prayers from different religions and The Easter Story.



4th—DT

Pupils will design and create their own Greek inspired patterned cushion focusing on developing their textile skills.



1st—History

Pupils will develop historical knowledge and skills related to the topic about the Ancient Greeks.



PSHE

Pupils will focus on the themes Dreams and Goals and Healthy Me.



Music

Pupils will develop knowledge and skills through learning about Pop Ballads and Hip Hop.



ICT

Pupils will learn about databases and how to create a digital game.



PE

Pupils will focus on gymnastics and invasion games



3rd—Art

Pupils will study the artist Kate Malone and make their own Greek vases developing their sculpture techniques using clay.



2nd—Geography
