Reading

This term our reading focus will be:

- Non-Fiction—Biographical writing

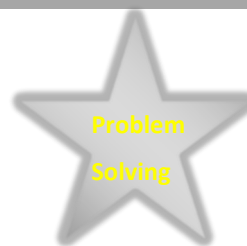


Numeracy

This term our numeracy focus will be:

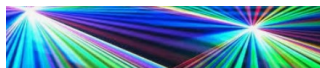
- Number and place value.

Pupils will focus on invasion games and dance

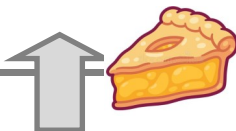


Our Topic this term is:

4th—DT

Pupils will develop historical knowledge and skills related to the topic about WW2 and the Blitz.



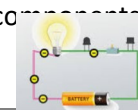
1st/2nd—Geography
