Impact Report

Year 1: in Writing and Maths PP pupils have diminished the gap with Non PP pupils, making better progress in Writing and Maths. This is as a result of Quality First Coaching and the use of numicon.

Year 2: The gap in all subjects has diminished as a result of small group tuition and Quality First Coaching.

Year 3: in Reading the gap with Non PP pupils has diminished, pupils making better progress in Reading so that the attainment gap is now less than half a term. This is as a result of increased flexibility in grouping learners, enabling their needs to be better met and quality feedback and marking.

Year 4: in Reading, Writing and Maths PP pupils have diminished the gap with Non PP pupils, making better progress in Maths. PP pupils attainment is greater than those who are not this is as a result of Quality First Teaching.

Year 5 PP pupils have made better progress in Reading than Non PP pupils. The gaps are diminishing in Writing and Maths as a result of reducing class size, improved feedback and Quality First Teaching.

Year 6 The gap in attainment in about one term in all subjects between PP pupils and Non PP pupils. The gap is progress is minimal in Reading and Writing and is less than half a term in maths. This is as a result of reducing class size through additional teachers and Quality First Teaching.
