

Stow Heath Primary School Year 5 Spring Term

Our Topic is - 'The Ancient Greeks'



In History we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks. We will be researching Greek warfare and the differences between Athens and Sparta. We will also discover the beliefs of the Ancient Greeks and their everyday lives.

In DT, we will be researching Greek patterns. We will then use various joining techniques for fabrics in order to create our Greek inspired patterned cushion covers or pencil cases.

In Science we are investigating Materials and changes to their properties. We will be grouping materials, investigating soluble materials, saturation and reversible and irreversible changes. We will experiment with how materials react under extreme temperature changes such as burning and freezing.

Literacy

- Throughout the half term the children will be reading a variety of genres including argument texts, poems, persuasive texts and Greek myth.
- They will be learning new grammar concepts and applying their knowledge in their writing.
- Children will become confident writers by using different sentence structures and various conjunctions within their work.
- Children who show significant improvements in their writing will be rewarded by being allowed to write in pen.

Numeracy

During this half term the children will be focusing on the following topics –

- Fractions finding equivalent fractions as well as adding and subtracting them.
- We will be recognising mixed number fractions and converting from one form to another.
- We will be multiplying proper fractions.
- Measurement- we will be converting measures, such as mm to cm, KM to M, Kg to g as well as estimating capacity.
- We will approximate equivalences between metric units and imperial measures.
