Reading

This term our reading focus will be:

- Recounts & Diaries - Diary of a Killer Cat
- Stories about imaginary words - Stone Age Boy
- Shape Poems
- Stories from other cultures—Anansi
- Letters - Dear Father Christmas
- Traditional Poems - Twas the Night Before Christmas
- Information texts about Rocks and Soil, Forces & Magnets and The Stone age



Writing

This term our writing focus will be:

- Non-Fiction—Diary entries
- Fiction—Stories about imaginary worlds
- Poetry—Shape poems
- Fiction—Stories from other cultures
- Non-Fiction—Letters
- Poetry— Traditional poems



Numeracy

This term our numeracy focus will be:

- Number and place value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division

Children will also develop their mental math skills, through the 'Shooting Math's Stars' scheme. Each week children will be tested and move up the different star levels.



Science 1

Pupils will learn to compare and group different kinds of rocks and learn how soil and fossils are formed.



Our Topic this term is:

Science 2

Pupils will learn how things move on different surfaces and how magnets work.



RE

Pupils will explore ideas about God and the two Christmas stories— Matthew and Luke.



PSHE

Pupils will focus on the themes Being In My World and Celebrating Difference.



Music

Pupils will build on their musical skills through R&B, Motown and Soul music .



1st—History

Pupils will develop historical knowledge and skills related to changes in Britain from the stone age to the iron age.



ICT

Pupils will learn about coding, online safety and spreadsheets.



4th— DT

Pupils will design and create their own large scale structure using large construction materials based on Stone Age living.



2nd—Geography

Pupils will develop geographical knowledge and skills related to learning about hill forts and how these have changed over time.



3rd—Art

Pupils will learn about movement in art and create their own cave drawings and paintings
